All ordained men are invited to participate in the Ordination Council Sunday, June 27 at 4 p.m. in Room 28.

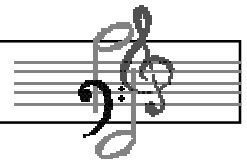

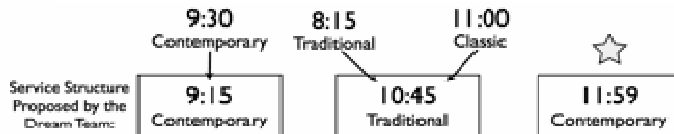

Tuesday May 18 was a night I will never forget. The Dream Team meeting we held in Room 28 was one of the most spiritual, worshipful meetings in which I've ever participated. God showed up and gave great guidance and direction and unity to our thoughts and plans. It is exciting to think of all that will happen over the next ten years as we look at Immanuel's 20/20 Vision. There are a number of things we'll need to do over the next ten years, but perhaps what is most pressing on us as a church is what we can do right now. Sunday, May 23, I presented some slides to the church detailing our explosive church-wide growth. The fastest growing segment of that growth was in our 9:30 service. After much prayer, several weeks of thought and discussion amongst our staff and the Dream Team, the recommendation was unanimously made by the dream team to begin a second contemporary style worship service at 11:59.



I've been told by Bro. Rick and others that one of the reasons we began our 8:15 service was to make room for the growth at 11:00. This was prior to the remodeling of the Sanctuary. In other words, there wasn't enough space for all the 11:00 worshippers if the current growth trends held true (which they did). Fast forward 6 years, and take into consideration the added seating capacity in the sanctuary, and we could very feasibly combine the 8:15 & 11:00 services in order to start a second contemporary service to make space for the fast growing population of contemporary style worshippers. What a blessing from God to be a part of a church that is reaching people for Jesus, and is willing to sacrifice to follow Holy Spirit's leadership.

## His own man?

Sometimes a person will be described as "his own man." It's a claim that he owes nothing to anyone else. For some people, this idea may become a source of high pride.

But does anyone actually belong only to himself; with no obligation to any other? The Bible says clearly, "Know that the Lord, he is God: it is he who has made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture" (Psalm 100:3). What the Hebrew actually says is, "We are not our own." as the next phrase says, "We are His." The Bible teaches not only that everything we have is God's, but that we ourselves are God's. Not only can we not withhold money or things from God, but we must not withhold our very lives from Him.

Paul said the Macedonian Christians realized this, for when they gave to missions, they first gave themselves to the Lord, and [then] to us by the will of God (2 Cor. 8:5). After their first decision to acknowledge that they themselves belonged to God, the next decision about what money to give was much easier to make. It will be for us, too.



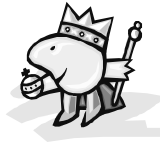
